2007 Tenuta Belguardo Morellino di Scansano  
Poggio Bronzone

Rating: 90  
Drink: 2010-2015

The 2007 Morellino di Scansano Bronzone is beautifully plump and juicy in this vintage. Jammy raspberries, flowers, spices and earthiness are some of the aromas and flavors that emerge from this opulent, silky red. The intensity of the fruit flows through to the refined, polished finish. Readers who haven't yet explored the Morellinos from Scansano are missing out on some of the most delicious reds in all of Italy. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2015.

With one exception, I was blown away by the wines I tasted from Fonterutoli, the Mazzei family's historic Tuscan property. Proprietor Filippo Mazzei and his team led by consulting oenologist Carlo Ferrini have done a terrific job with most of these wines.

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2008 Mazzei Fonterutoli Chianti Classico

Rating: 90  
Drink: 2010-2016


The 2008 Chianti Classico Fonterutoli is impressive juice. A melange of mineral-infused scents add complexity to the dark cherry fruit. Medium in body, the Chianti Classico shows wonderful freshness, clarity and verve. While it doesn't appear to have the density to support extended cellaring, this is one of the most finessed Chiantis I tasted from the uneven 2008 vintage. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2016.

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2007 Tenuta Belguardo Belguardo

Rating: 91  
Drink: 2012-2022

The 2007 Tenuta Belguardo, a French-oak aged Cabernet Sauvignon/Cabernet Franc blend captures all of the qualities of this important Tuscan vintage. Finely knit tannins support an expressive, radiant core of fruit. Compared to most of its peers, this is a decidedly bright, floral Cabernet that relies more on elegance than sheer power. Hints of smoke, tar and scorched earth add complexity on the round, generous close. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2022.

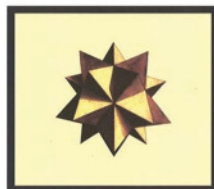

**89** Mazzei 2008 Serrata Belguardo (Maremma); \$20. Here's a fresh and cheerful Sangiovese-based wine that shows bright berry tones and soft spice nuances. It proves a very food-friendly wine that would pair with pasta, light meat dishes or rolled pork roast. Imported by Palm Bay International.



**94** Mazzei 2007 Tenuta Belguardo (Maremma); \$70. You'll love the tones of rich chocolate, leather, berry fruit, cassis and vanilla. All those aromas are backed by dense, rich extraction and smooth softness. Imported by Palm Bay International.



**95** Mazzei 2007 Castello di Fonterutoli Siepi (Toscana); \$120.

Siepi is a gorgeous super Tuscan blend of Sangiovese and Merlot that exhibits richness, intensity and purity. This is a luscious and opulent expression with deep aromas of cherry, blackberry, chocolate, espresso bean and spice. The finish is super long and delicious.
