In der Aktuellen Ausgabe, N° 185 vom 31.10.2009, des WINE ADVOCATE wurden die Weine von Prunotto durchweg sehr gut bewertet. Der Durchschnittswert der Bewertungen liegt bei außergewöhnlichen 90,5 Punkten!

Besonders herausragend wurde der neue Jahrgang 2005 bewertet. Der Italien-Experte Antonio Galloni schreibt über den Barolo 2005:

*“The 2005 Barolo a multi-commune wine made from vineyards in Monforte, Serralunga and Castiglione Falletto. It is a terrific, over-achieving wine in this vintage, with plenty of persistence in its dark cherries, prunes and spices, all of which meld together in a harmonious, beautifully balanced Barolo of the highest level. The tannins remain quite firm, so patience is the key. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2025. I was very impressed with the wines I tasted from Prunotto this year. The Barolos and Barbarescos in particular are wonderful.”*

## 2006 Alfredo Prunotto Barbaresco

Rating: 90  
Drink: 2014-2021

The 2006 Barbaresco Classico is a pretty, mid-weight wine with a floral bouquet and attractive dark red fruit. The Barbaresco is a little lean today but should fill out nicely with bottle age, as the balance is outstanding. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2021.

I was very impressed with the wines I tasted from Prunotto this year. The Barolos and Barbarescos in particular are wonderful.

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## 2005 Alfredo Prunotto Barbaresco Bric Turot

Rating: 92  
Drink: 2012-2025

The estate's 2005 Barbaresco Bric Turot shows off a super-ripe, rich expression of fruit, along with spices, minerals and French oak. The wine reveals considerable depth, with a long and polished finish. Dark raspberries, cherries, plums and flowers linger on the close. This is an exceptional Barbaresco from Prunotto. Anticipated maturity: 2012-2025.

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## 2006 Alfredo Prunotto Barbera d'Alba Pian Romualdo

Rating: 88  
Drink: 2009-2012

The 2006 Barbera d'Alba Pian Romualdo is soft and sensual in its layers of perfumed dark fruit. This accessible Pian Romualdo offers excellent balance and harmony, although in the 2006 vintage a touch more complexity and personality should have been possible. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2012.

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## 2005 Alfredo Prunotto Barbera d'Asti Costamiolo

Rating: 89  
Drink: 2010-2020

The 2005 Barbera D'Asti Costamiolo reveals plenty of definition in its red fruit, minerals and flowers, all of which come together in the linear, focused style that is typical of the Barberas from Asti. A clean, refreshing finish rounds out the wine nicely. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2020.

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## 2005 Alfredo Prunotto Barolo

Rating: 92  
Drink: 2015-2025

The 2005 Barolo a multi-commune wine made from vineyards in Monforte, Serralunga and Castiglione Falletto. It is a terrific, over-achieving wine in this vintage, with plenty of persistence in its dark cherries, prunes and spices, all of which meld together in a harmonious, beautifully balanced Barolo of the highest level. The tannins remain quite firm, so patience is the key. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2025.

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## 2005 Alfredo Prunotto Barolo Bussia

Rating: 93+  
Drink: 2015-2030

The 2005 Barolo Bussia is a gorgeous, ripe wine layered with scents of menthol, spices and minerals that complement a generous core of fruit. The French oak is beautifully integrated and the wine possesses exceptional overall balance, with a round, harmonious finish. This is a highly promising Barolo from Prunotto. Anticipated maturity: 2015-2030.

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## 2007 Alfredo Prunotto Monferrato Rosso Mompertone

Rating: 90  
Drink: 2010-2017

The 2007 Monferrato Mompertone (60% Barbera, 40% Syrah) is a juicy, rewarding wine. Still rather backward, this richly-textured offering is packed with jammy dark fruits, herbs, tar, smoke and minerals. With another few months in bottle, the Mompertone should be terrific. This French oak-aged blend of Barbera and Syrah is in just its third vintage, but the combination undoubtedly works very nicely here. Anticipated maturity: 2010-2017.

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## 2006 Alfredo Prunotto Nebbiolo d'Alba Occhetti

Rating: 90  
Drink: 2009-2021

The 2006 Nebbiolo d'Alba Occhetti is an attractive, full-bodied Nebbiolo with tons of depth and persistence in its dark fruit. Suggestions of menthol, spices and flowers add further complexity. This delicious Nebbiolo is yet another important wine from Piedmont's Roero district. Anticipated maturity: 2009-2021.

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
